NOTICE OF INTENT TO LIEN - With regard to residential projects, everyone, including those in contract with the owner, must provide a 15 day notice of intent to lien prior to filing a notice of lien claim. A notice of intent to lien is a lot like a demand letter. It is a document mailed to the owner's warning that if payment isn't made, the claimant intends to file a mechanics lien.

Purpose of Mechanic's Liens. Mechanic's liens are legal documents that essentially reserve the rights of the filer to seek unpaid compensation. They are usually filed by contractors, subcontractors, or suppliers that never received payment for work that they performed or materials that they provided on the property.
